The promoter does not provide medical insurance. We urge you not to operate a motorcycle without medical coverage.

If you have any doubts about your personal ability to participate in this event, if you have not adequately prepared yourself and your equipment, if you question the condition and safety of local public highways, or if you believe your personal insurance coverage's are not adequate to compensate you for any loss that may occur, we urge you to notify the promoter who will immediately refund your entry fee.
