## Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, was declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. **COVID-19 is extremely contagious**. As a result, the State of California<sup>1</sup> and the County of San Bernardino<sup>2</sup> have issued emergency regulations to address COVID-19.

The Big Bear Trail Riders ("BBTR"), pursuant to then current guidelines, has put in place preventative measures to reduce the likelihood of the spread of COVID-19. However, the BBTR cannot guarantee that you and/or your family will not become infected with COVID-19 during your voluntary activity at the Dual Sport Event on June 26 thru June 28, 2020.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my family and/or I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the Dual Sport Event on June 26 thru 28, 2020 and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my family and/or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I and/or my family may experience or incur in connection with my or my family's attendance at the Dual Sport Event ("Claims") of June 26 thru 28, 2020. On my behalf, and on behalf of my family, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the BBTR, its members, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the BBTR, its members, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after my or our participation in any activities at the Dual Sport Event of June 26 thru 28, 2020.
